REGULATIONS

THE PHOTO AND VIDEO SESSION can be done at the National Museum of the Village "Dimitrie Gusti" in the following conditions and according to the legislation in force on the protection of cultural heritage:

- **PROFESSIONAL (WITH COMMERCIAL PURPOSE) - with taxes** imposed by the Orders of the Minister of Culture no. 2032 / 15.01.2019 and 3136 / 27.08.2020.

- **NON-PROFESSIONAL (FOR OWN USE WITHOUT COMMERCIAL PURPOSE) - without taxes** but with the obligation to complete personal data in the PHOTO-VIDEO REGISTER from TICKET OFFICES;
By filling in the data in that REGISTER, the applicant assumes the processing of personal data by the "Dimitrie Gusti" National Village Museum; the data collected are for informational purposes and can be used for reports on institutional transparency, controls from competent institutions, internal reports of the National Village Museum "Dimitrie Gusti";
- **FOR WEDDING PICTURES/VIDEOS, CIVIL WEDDING, TRASH THE DRESS, SAVE THE DRESS, BAPTISM (FOR OWN USE WITHOUT COMMERCIAL PURPOSE) - a fee of 200 lei** will be paid;
 - in compliance with the ban on filming / photography inside the monuments of the permanent outdoor exhibition;
 - it is not allowed to use the DRONE!
 - in compliance with the Covid-19 norms according to the orders in force regarding the measures for the prevention of contamination with the new Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 and for ensuring the development of the activities in conditions of sanitary safety in the field of culture;

THE APPLICANT MUST:

- * to request in writing THE PHOTO SESSION AND PROFESSIONAL FILMING - at the following mail adress: contact@muzeul-satului.ro or by request submitted physically, at the Secretariat of the Museum from Kiseleff Blvd, no. 30, sector 1, Bucharest; the request must include **all the data** for which the PHOTO SESSION AND / OR PROFESSIONAL FILMING is requested; response time - between 10-30 working days, depending on how elaborate the request is;
- to organize the PHOTO SESSION AND PROFESSIONAL FILMING ONLY in the space provided and approved by the management of the Museum, as established by mutual agreement;
- not to organize a party with food and drink in the space intended for the Photo Session and Professional Filming; the space is intended only for the requested event;
- to keep the decency of the clothing and of an attitude appropriate to the museum institution;
- not to promote political values and other ideas that contradict the image of a museum institution;
- not to affect in any way the integrity of the monuments, or of the space in which the event takes place (no nails are nailed, no hanging, no support of monuments);
- to connect to utilities only with the approval and under the supervision of the specialized staff of the Museum; connection and use of water, electricity, gas is done for a fee (50 lei / hour), cost separate from other taxes;
- not to use defective equipment or with technical modifications;
- **THE USE OF DRONE FILM APPLIANCES IS NOT PERMITTED;**
- not to use open fire (bottles, fireworks, gas-based fumigants, lighters, candles, scented sticks, carbonic ice, etc.);
- not to smoke inside the Museum and to inform guests about this rule!
- the use of lanterns, vehicles and motor vehicles, live animals inside the Museum is prohibited;
- keep clean in the organization of the activity (it is forbidden to use confetti or other materials that spread easily);



- to collect their waste at the end of the event and to evacuate it from the Museum premises through their own resources;
- to follow exactly the instructions received from the Museum staff in order to avoid any violations of the legal norms regarding the protection of the museum patrimony and to avoid causing damage to the Museum;
- to follow exactly the instructions received from the Museum staff in order to avoid any violations of the legal norms regarding the protection of the museum patrimony and to avoid causing damage to the Museum;
- to comply with the PSI norms and to assume responsibility for any damages caused through their own fault regarding the deterioration of the cultural heritage, of the green spaces, possible fires caused by the non-observance of the PSI norms or by the non-observance of the smoking norms).

THIS REGULATION complies with the rules for the application of the Museum's ROI and ROF, as well as the rules on EMERGENCY SITUATIONS.

- This **Regulation** constitutes an Annex to the Contract concluded between the petitioner and the Museum; by signing the agreement, you acknowledge that you are in a public institution with photo and video surveillance and exposure;
- If, by any means, the Museum becomes aware of the breach of the obligation to use abusively or for purposes other than those provided in this agreement for filming made inside the Museum, it has the right to sue you and seek damages, under Law 8/1996 on copyright.
- In case of material damage is found by destroying / damaging the monuments and patrimony objects inside the Museum, it has the obligation to immediately notify the police bodies for the civil, contraventional or criminal prosecution, as the case may be, of the persons who they are guilty of violating the legislation on the protection of cultural heritage.

** In accordance with the Order of the Minister on measures to prevent contamination with the new Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 and to ensure the development of activities in health safety in the field of culture, in force at the present date, the National Village Museum "Dimitrie Gusti" provides to its visiting public:*

- Hand sanitizers at each entrance to the museum;
- Checking the temperature by means of thermo-scanners at the museum entrances;
- Possibility of payments through POS;
- Safety spaces, delimited as such;
- Properly marked visit flows;
- Possibility to purchase non-surgical masks from the Museum Store;
- Posters, announcements and billboards with instructions for ensuring a safe environment from a health point of view;

When organizing the Photo Session and professional filming, the organizers and participants must follow the following rules:

- Wearing a protective mask at the entrance to the museum and for the situation in which you use closed spaces (visiting heritage monuments, shops, exhibition halls, toilets);
- Checking the temperature at the entrance to the museum (where there are thermo-scanners); If the recorded temperature exceeds 37.3 ° C it is forbidden to participate in the event;
- Avoiding the formation of groups; a group of up to 5 people is allowed;
- Washing and disinfecting hands whenever needed;
- Maintaining a physical distance of 1.5 m between people;
- Throwing the mask in the trash in separate containers, marked accordingly;

** Depending on the evolution of the pandemic with SARS-CoV-2, the requested actions may involve changes that will be announced in the answers formulated to the applicant.*
